NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to Regulation 22.1(b) of the Local Authorities (Members' Allowances) (England) Regulations 2003 ('the Regulations') that, following consideration of recommendations from an Independent Remuneration Panel in accordance with Regulation 3 of the Regulations, the City Council approved the following allowances with effect from 1 April 2010:

- A basic allowance of £5,250.00 per annum
- A special responsibility multiplier added to the basic allowance:-

- Childcare and dependent carers' allowance £7.64 per hour (based on scale point 11 of the Local Government Pay Spine)
- An Internet Service Provider Charges payment of a maximum of £10 per calendar month claimable by councillors who do not accept to use the broadband service provided by the Council.
