Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions

Where licence authorises supply of alcohol

No supply of alcohol may be made under this licence

- a. at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of this licence, or
- b. at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended

Every supply of alcohol under this licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Age Verification Policy

- (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
- (2) The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.
- (3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either –
 - a) A holographic mark, or
 - b) An ultraviolet feature

Below Cost Ban

A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.

For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 1 -

- (a) 'duty' is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979(6)
- (b) 'permitted price' is the price found by applying the formula -

$$P \text{ equals } D + (D \times V)$$

where -

- (i) P is the permitted price,
 - (ii) D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and
 - (iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;
- (c) 'relevant person' means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence -
- (i) the holder of the premises licence,
 - (ii) the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
 - (iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence;

- (d) 'relevant person' means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and
- (e) 'value added tax' means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994(7)

Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

There are to be no sales of beer, lager or cider over 6.5%ABV.

The Premises Licence holder shall ensure that all persons who work in the premises are adequately trained and informed regarding licensing law and in particular relating to the prevention of underage sales and all conditions and restrictions on the premises licence.

The Premises Licence holder shall ensure all persons who work in the premises undergo periodic refresher training relating to statutory provisions regulating the trading of the shop.

To display proof of age-related warning notices on the entrance door and inside the premises especially at the point of sale and to be visible to staff and customers.

Spirits shall only be displayed behind the serving counter.

No alcohol shall be displayed within three meters of the entrance, except for behind the counter.

A minimum of two staff shall be on duty at the premises from 20:00 until premises closure.

Staff are to check the immediate exterior of the premises and clear any litter emanating there from.

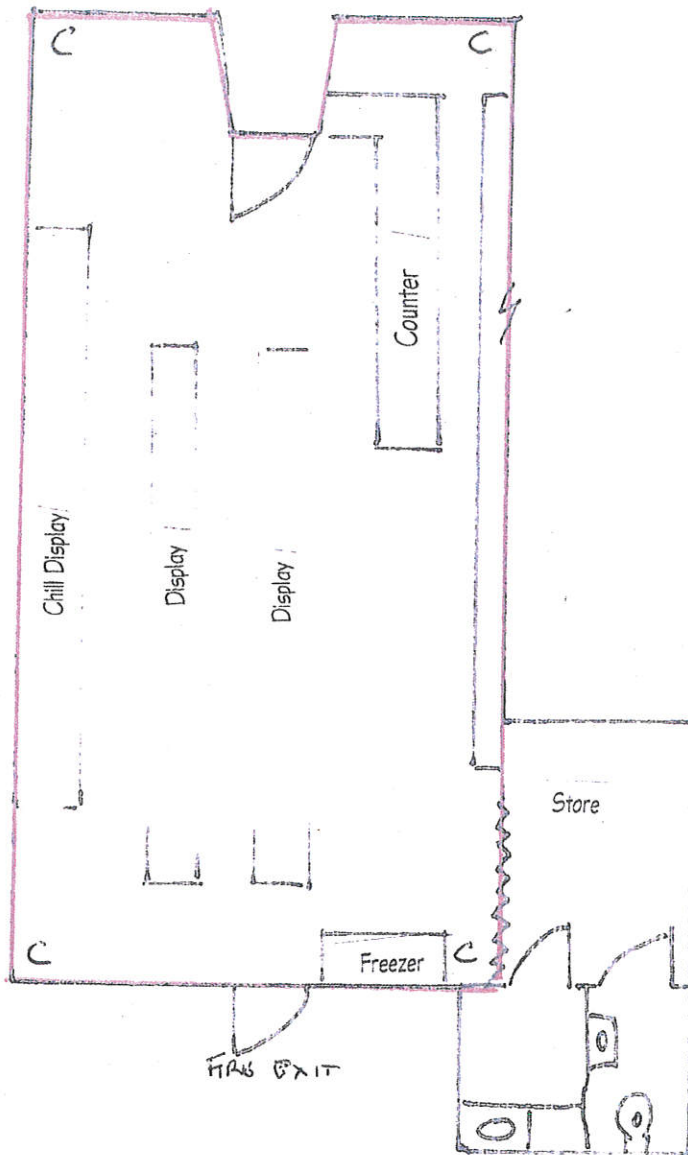
To adopt a Challenge 25 scheme such that no persons who appear to be under 25 years shall be served alcohol unless satisfactory proof of age is produced i.e. passport, driving licence or PASS approved holographic identity card ; including recording relevant details of refusals in a refusals record book, and making the same available for inspection on reasonable request being made.

Installation and maintenance of a CCTV system, including retention of recorded images for 31 days and making images available to the relevant statutory authorities on reasonable request being made.




