1. THE LATE NIGHT VENUE WILL BE MARKETED AS A PREMIUM SITE IN ITS CUSTOMER OFFERING AND ON SATURDAY NIGHTS WILL BE OVER 21S ONLY. LIVE ENTERTAINMENT, WILL BE A FEATURE OF THE VENUE ON FRIDAY AND SATURDAY NIGHTS APPEALING TO AN OLDER AUDIENCE WITH TABLE SERVICE AND VERY DIFFERENT TO THE CUSTOMER PROPOSITION IN EASTGATE STREET AND MORE ATTRACTIVE TO DINERS AFTER 10PM FROM THE PUBLIC HOUSE ADJOINING AS WELL AS CUSTOMERS AFTER THEY HAVE FINISHED DINING AT THE MANY RESTAURANTS IN THE QUAYS.

FOR A PERIOD OF 30 MINUTES FOLLOWING THE CLOSURE OF THE VENUE BAR , OR UNTIL ALL CUSTOMERS HAVE DISPERSED FROM THE IMMEDIATE VICINITY, AT LEAST HALF OF THE DOOR SUPERVISORS SHALL PATROL IMMEDIATELY OUTSIDE THE PREMISES WEARING HIGH VISIBILITY CLOTHING TO ENSURE THE SAFE, ORDERLY AND QUIET DISPERSAL OF CUSTOMERS IN THE IMMEDIATE VICINITY.
2. A "WINDING DOWN AND DISPERSAL" POLICY SHALL BE ADOPTED THAT INCLUDES MEASURES TO ACHIEVE A GRADUAL AND ORDERLY DISPERSAL OF CUSTOMERS AT THE END OF A TRADING SESSION. THESE MEASURES SHALL COMMENCE AT LEAST 30 MINUTES BEFORE THE BAR CLOSES, AND SHALL INCLUDE SLOWING DOWN THE TEMPO OF MUSIC, A REDUCTION IN THE VOLUME OF MUSIC (GRADUALLY REDUCING TO A BACKGROUND LEVEL) AND ANNOUNCEMENTS BY DJ OR ENTERTAINERS (ON OCCASIONS THEY ARE USED) REQUESTING CUSTOMERS TO LEAVE THE PREMISES QUIETLY AND RESPECT THE PEACE AND QUIET OF LOCAL RESIDENTS. BOTH THE FRONT DOORS ONTO BRUNSWICK ROAD AS WELL AS THE SIDE DOORS ONTO JENNINGS WALK WILL BE UTILISED WHEN CLOSING TO ASSIST DISPERSAL.
3. AFTER 23.00 HOURS, ALL EXTERNAL DOORS AND WINDOWS IN AREAS WHERE ANY LIVE OR RECORDED ENTERTAINMENT (OTHER THAN LOW LEVEL BACKGROUND MUSIC) OCCURS SHALL BE KEPT SHUT DURING THESE ACTIVITIES (EXCEPT IN THE CASE OF AN EMERGENCY, OR MOMENTARILY IN THE CASE OF THE MAIN FRONT ACCESS DOOR).
4. THE DPS SHALL ENSURE EFFECTIVE OVERALL MANAGEMENT OF MUSIC VOLUME, SUCH AS MONITORING NOISE LEVELS OUTSIDE THE PREMISES, TO ENSURE THAT NOISE FROM SUCH ACTIVITIES IS INAUDIBLE INSIDE NEARBY NOISE SENSITIVE PREMISES.

5. THE DPS SHALL TAKE MEASURES TO ENSURE THAT NOISE LEVELS FROM CUSTOMERS SHALL NOT BE CLEARLY AUDIBLE IN ANY NEARBY NOISE SENSITIVE PROPERTY, THESE MEASURES MAY INCLUDE THE USE OF SIGNS , LIMITING SMOKERS AT ANY ONE TIME IN THE ENCLOSED OUTDOOR AREA , WARNING NOISY CUSTOMERS THAT THE RIGHT TO RE-ADMISSION MAY BE WITHDRAWN ETC.

e) The protection of children from harm

THE CHALLENGE 25 SCHEME AND DRUGS POLICY SHALL BE ADOPTED, SO THAT ANY CUSTOMER ATTEMPTING TO PURCHASE ALCOHOLIC LICQUOR WHO APPEARS TO BE UNDER THE AGE OF 25 SHALL BE ASKED FOR AN ACCREDITED PHOTOGRAPHIC PROOF OF THEIR AGE (EG PASSPORT , PHOTO DRIVING LICENCE OR PASS- APPROVED CARD AND THAT A SALE SHALL NOT BE MADE UNLESS THIS EVIDENCE IS PRODUCED.
