My main concerns regarding this application are noise and odour due to the upper floors of the building being residential flats. On looking at the planning permission for the premises I have found that odour has already been discussed and dealt with. As such this representation focuses on noise due to the applicants request for live and amplified music.

The below email was sent to the applicant requesting the agreement of conditions: Dear Mr Karayiannis,

I have been consulted by Gloucester City Council's Licensing Team on this application for a premises license and I have a couple of concerns regarding your wish to have live and amplified music given the extremely close proximity of residential flats above the premises.

I am less concerned with the recorded music as this is likely to be in the background whilst patrons eat at your premises however I would like to agree some conditions with you regarding your wish to hold live music at the premises during private functions and special events as per your application. The conditions I would like to agree with you regarding noise are as follows:

- Doors and windows will be kept shut during live or regulated entertainment.
- The DPS shall ensure effective overall management of music volume, such as monitoring noise levels outside the premises, to ensure that noise from such activities is inaudible inside nearby noise sensitive premises.

My other concern regarding noise affecting the above residential properties are deliveries to the premises/ waste collections. I would like to agree the below condition which ensures that deliveries and collections are reasonable and follows on from the one of the measures you recommended in Section 18 of your application:

• The loading and unloading of service and delivery vehicles together with their arrival and departure from the site shall not take place outside the following times: Monday-Friday 8.00 am-6.00pm, Saturday 8.00 am-1.00 pm nor at any time on Sundays, Bank or Public Holidays.

Unfortunately I go on leave from the end of play today until Monday 13th June and so I have copied in colleagues to this email who will be able to help and respond in my absence. Please can you confirm via email whether you are happy to accept the above 3 conditions so that we can forward a response onto our Licensing Team.
