Strong management controls and effective training of all staff so that they are aware of the premises license and the requirements to meet the four licensing objectives with particular attention to:

- 1: No selling of alcohol to underage people
- 2: No drunk and disorderly behavior on the premises area
- 3: Vigilance in preventing the use and sale of illegal drugs around the area
- 4: No violent and anti-social behavior
- 5: No harm to children
- Operating Schedule providing the hours of operation and licensable activities during those hours.
- Challenge 25 information to prevent the supply of alcohol to under-age drinkers.
- CCTV system installed with recording option available

As a licensed premises we know that it is necessary to carry out our business activities with a purpose of promoting these objectives. We will support these objectives through our operating schedules and other systems & controls plus working alongside the Police, Council and area management teams

## b) The prevention of crime and disorder

CCTV System installed to monitor entrances, exits, and other parts of the premises in order to address the prevention of crime objective.

A clear and legible notice outside the premises indicating the normal hours under the terms of the premises license during which licensable activities are permitted.

Clear and conspicuous notices warning of potential criminal activity, such as theft, that may target customers will be displayed.

Not selling alcohol to underage, drunk or intoxicated customers.

Custom will not be sought by means of personal solicitation outside or in the vicinity of the premises.

Prevention and vigilance in illegal drug use around the facility

Staff will be well trained in asking customers to use premises in an orderly and respectful manner, including the surrounding area

## c) Public safety

Internal and external lighting fixed to promote the public safety objective.

Well trained staff adherence to environmental health requirements.

Training and implementation of underage ID checks.

A log book or recording system shall be kept upon the premises in which shall be entered particulars of inspections made; those required to be made by statute, and information compiled to comply with any public safety condition attached to the premises license that requires the recording of such information. The log book shall be kept available for inspection when required by persons authorised by the Licensing Act 2003 or associated legislation.

## d) The prevention of public nuisance

Promotion of prevention of public nuisance to nearby residents.

The Licensee will ensure that staff who arrive early morning or depart late at night when the business has ceased trading conduct themselves in such a manner to avoid causing disturbance to nearby residents.

Customers will be encouraged to leave the premises and area, in a respectable fashion, outside operating hours

Customers will not be admitted to premises outside of operating hours.

Any lighting on or outside the premises will be positioned and screened in such a way so as to not cause a disturbance to nearby residents.

#### e) The protection of children from harm

"Challenge 25" sign which is a retailing strategy that encourages anyone who is over 18 but looks under 25 to carry acceptable ID (a card bearing the PASS hologram, a photographic driving license or a passport) if they wish to buy alcohol.

Well trained staff about requirement for persons' identification, age establishment etc.

All the details provided in Training Record Book available at the facility - Log Book will be kept upon the premises all the time.
