Councillor Phil McLellan to Cabinet Member for Environment	“Can the Cabinet member advise me of what is happening to the animal stock held by the Countryside Unit including the City Farm?”	“Stock required for continued operation of the City Farm will be transferred to the charity. The Council will retain sufficient stock to undertake grazed management of areas such as Robinswood Hill, Alney Island and Hucclecote Meadows. Animals surplus to these requirements have been sold to reputable individuals and organisations with similar rare breed or farm park operations.”
