Thanks for the e-mail, after attending the last Barnwood Community Partnership meeting I can confirm that both the local community and the Police wish to apply for a DPPO for the Green space off Barnwood road, designated as Greenways. I will drop a map into you asap.

Over the last 6 months we have had 11 calls of ASB in this area, residents believe some of this to be alcohol related. On a site visit with Phillipa Finnigan we found evidence of drinking in the bushes on this site. This took the form of discarded cans, bottles, etc.

Please accept this e-mail as an official request to proceed with a DPPO application, this also has the support of Cllr Noakes & McLellan local Barnwood Councillors.
