

APPOINTMENTS MADE AT ANNUAL COUNCIL MEETING MONDAY 23 MAY 2016

Including appointments to Committees, Consultative Forums and Working Groups and Nomination for Chairs of Committees and Vice Chairs for 2016/17

NB. The appointment of Chairs and Vice Chairs to Committees will be confirmed at the first meeting of each Committee

Recommendations

Council is asked to **RESOLVE** that

- (1) The schedule of appointments of Members to Committees, Consultative Forums and Working Groups for 2016/17 be approved.
- (2) In respect of the above, the Council, in accordance with Council Procedure Rules, appoint all Members as named deputies for all those meetings (with the exception of Cabinet, Planning Committee and Licensing and Enforcement Committee) to which the Member has not been appointed.
- (3) That the nominations for Chair and Vice Chair of Committees, as set out in the schedule, be noted and that each Committee at its first meeting in the new municipal year 2016/17 confirms and appoints its Chair and Vice Chair.

The political balance calculation in respect of the total number of committee seats includes main or parent committees only. Seats on sub-committees are determined separately. In accordance with the Council's Constitution, representation on the following committees/bodies is **not** subject to political balance rules.

- Senior Appointments Committee
- Appeals Committee
- Regeneration Advisory Board
- Gloucestershire Police and Crime Panel
- Safer Gloucester Partnership
- Gloucestershire Economic Growth Joint Committee
- Gloucestershire Joint Waste Committee
- Constitution Working Group
- One Legal Joint Liaison and Monitoring Group
- Member Development Working Group

Alternative arrangements for appointments to these committees/bodies can be approved provided no Member of the Council votes against.

The number of seats held by the three political groups expressed as a percentage on the City Council (39) is:

Conservative 22 seats (% of 39) = 56.41%Labour 10 seats (% of 39) = 25.64%Liberal Democrat 7 seats (% of 39) = 17.95%

When applied to the total number of committee seats (55) seats these percentages give the following aggregate entitlement (rounded up/down to the nearest whole seat) for each Group:

Conservative 56.41% of 55 = **31** (31.03)
Labour 25.64% of 55 = **14** (14.11)
Liberal Democrat 17.95% of 55 = **10** (9.87) **Variance in total seats = 0**

When the same percentages are applied to the number of seats on each committee/body (assuming the committees/bodies remain the same size as in the last municipal year) they give the following provisional entitlement to seats on each committee/body, rounded up or

down to the nearest whole seat:
