Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

Where licence authorises supply of alcohol

No supply of alcohol may be made under this licence

- a. at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of this licence, or
- b. at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended

Every supply of alcohol under this licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Below Cost Ban

A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.

For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 1 -

- (a) 'duty' is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979(6)
- (b) 'permitted price' is the price found by applying the formula -

where -

- (i) P is the permitted price,
- (ii) D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and
- (iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;
- (c) 'relevant person' means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence -
 - (i) the holder of the premises licence,
 - (ii) the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
 - (iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence;
- (d) 'relevant person' means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and
- (e) 'value added tax' means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994(7)

Age Verification Policy

- (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
- (2) The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.
- (3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either —
- a) A holographic mark, or
- b) An ultraviolet feature

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

A CCTV system with minimum 4 colour cameras recording at a frame rate of not less than 15 frames per second shall be maintained in good working order at the store and shall record at all times the premises are open. Recordings shall be kept for a minimum of 14 days and shall be produced within 3 days on request of Police, Trading Standards or Council Officers.

The 'Challenge 25' scheme (or equivalent) shall be adopted, so that any customer attempting to purchase alcohol who appears to be under the age of 25 years shall be asked for an accredited photographic proof of age (PASS approved card, passport or photo driving licence) and that a sale shall not be made unless this evidence is produced.

Spirits shall be displayed only behind the counter.

All staff are to be trained and will have a full knowledge of all licensing issues under the 2003 Licensing Act, including the 'Challenge 25' rule.

The premises will be monitored externally for anti-social behaviour, public nuisance and litter.

The premises will only accept trade deliveries or rubbish collections during normal working hours.

A refusals register will be kept and all refusals by any member of staff will be recorded. The register will be made available to Responsible Authorities on request.
