Good Afternoon

As highway authority we cannot approve the location in The Oxebode for this trader for the following reasons:

- . The area forms part of the public highway and is for pedestrian use.
- . The footpath is constructed of York stone and is not suitable for vehicles to drive or park on. This area would quickly become damaged if this were to be approved.
- . There is no dropped kerb access for vehicles or trailers to access the footway, meaning kerbs would be damaged in the process of accessing the footway.

With the above in mind I would ask that this application is refused and an alternative location is found.
